Bulk billed appts available for the following patients or types of appts only	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Health Care Card holders• Pension Concession Card holders• DVA Gold Card holders• DVA White Card holders for the specified conditions only• Children under the age of 16• Chronic Disease Management and Health Assessments (often called GP Management Plan, Team Care Arrangements or Care Plan)• Home Medication Reviews• Closing the Gap Registered Patients <u>with a Healthcare card</u>• COVID-19 and Influenza Vaccinations• Regular Ongoing Dressings (after the initial consultation)• Regular ongoing cryotherapy or desensitisation injections after the initial consult• Routine INR testing and advice regarding warfarin dosage
Private fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All appointments on Saturday• All non-concessional card holders• All other appts NOT covered in the bulk billing eligibility box above
Procedural Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Procedural fees apply for all patients having surgical or treatment room procedures. The fee will depend on the complexity of your procedure.• Procedural fee is discounted for pension card and health care card holders and children under 16.• I will advise you of the procedure fee at the time of planning your procedure.

Payment must be made at the time of the consultation by cash, EFTPOS or credit card. QMSC uses the Easyclaim service, and your Medicare rebate will return, almost immediately, after swiping your EFTPOS card. Ensure your details are registered with Medicare.
